

STEP 1



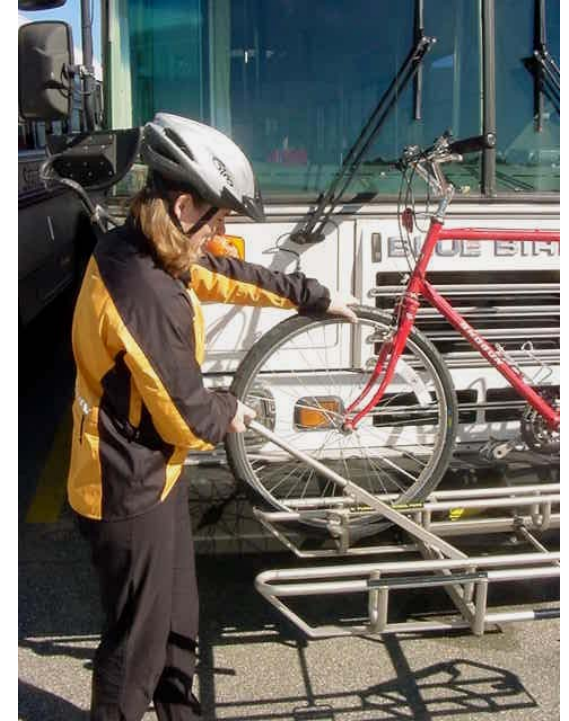
TO USE THE BICYCLE RACK, SQUEEZE THE RELEASE HANDLE AND LOWER THE RACK.

STEP 2



TO LOAD YOUR BICYCLE, USE THE SLOT CLOSEST TO THE BUS FIRST. MAKE CERTAIN EACH WHEEL IS IN THE PROPER SLOT. WHEEL SLOTS ARE CLEARLY LABELED FOR FRONT AND REAR TIRES.

STEP 3



TO SECURE YOUR BICYCLE, RAISE THE SUPPORT ARM TO THE TOP OF THE FRONT TIRE. NOW THE BICYCLE IS SECURE AND YOU MAY BOARD THE BUS.

STEP 4



TO REMOVE YOUR BICYCLE, LOWER THE SUPPORT ARM, THEN LIFT YOUR BICYCLE OUT OF THE RACK. IF NO ONE IS WAITING TO LOAD A BICYCLE, FOLD UP THE RACK AND THEN WALK YOUR BICYCLE TO THE CURB.

SAFETY TIPS

- WHEN LOADING OR UNLOADING, MAINTAIN AS MUCH EYE CONTACT WITH THE DRIVER AS POSSIBLE.
- AVOID KNEELING OR SQUATTING OUT OF THE DRIVER'S LINE OF SIGHT.
- BE SURE TO LOAD AND UNLOAD YOUR BICYCLE TOWARD THE CURB.
- WHEN APPROACHING AND LEAVING THE BUS, BE AWARE OF THE DRIVER'S BLIND SPOTS AND AVOID THEM. AREAS BEHIND THE BUS WHEELS ON BOTH SIDES ARE MAJOR BLIND SPOTS. SHOULD YOU APPROACH THE BUS FROM THESE ANGLES, YOU WILL BE OUTSIDE THE RANGE OF THE DRIVER'S MIRRORS.
- DO NOT EXPOSE YOURSELF TO TRAFFIC WHEN LOADING OR UNLOADING. THE BUS IS A MAJOR VISION BARRIER FOR OTHER MOTORISTS.
- AS A SAFETY PRECAUTION, WAIT UNTIL THE BUS MOVES AWAY BEFORE GETTING ON YOUR BICYCLE.
- ALWAYS WEAR A SAFETY HELMET WHEN RIDING YOUR BICYCLE (FOR CHILDREN UNDER 13 IT'S THE LAW).
- CHILDREN 12 AND YOUNGER MAY USE THE RACK WHEN ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT.
- HARVARD UNIVERSITY IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR DAMAGES INCURRED OR CAUSED BY BICYCLES, OR DAMAGES TO BICYCLES ON HARVARD SHUTTLE BICYCLE RACKS.

TYPES OF BICYCLES ALLOWED ON THE HARVARD SHUTTLE'S RACKS:

ONLY CONVENTIONAL SINGLE SEAT, TWO-WHEELED BICYCLES AND ELECTRIC BICYCLES THE SIZE OF A STANDARD BICYCLE ARE ALLOWED ON THE RACKS.

RACK ON



HARVARD'S SHUTTLE FLEET NOW SPORTS EXTERIOR BICYCLE RACKS THAT CAN HOLD TWO BICYCLES.

- YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR LOADING, SECURING AND REMOVING YOUR BICYCLE FROM THE BICYCLE RACK.
- AS A SHUTTLE APPROACHES, RAISE YOUR HAND TO ATTRACT THE ATTENTION OF THE DRIVER.
- AS YOU APPROACH YOUR STOP, ADVISE THE DRIVER THAT YOU WILL BE UNLOADING YOUR BICYCLE.

REMEMBER:
**NEVER CROSS THE STREET
IN FRONT OF THE BUS.
PASSING TRAFFIC CANNOT
SEE AROUND THE BUS.**
